50303 Board of Governors' Scholarships

The Board establishes a Board of Governors' Scholarship program that provides financial support to Nebraska residents who have the equivalent of a high school diploma.

Each Board of Governors' Scholarship will have a quarterly value of full-time tuition and mandatory fees. Any course-specific educational expenses will be the responsibility of the recipient. Each scholarship shall be for a maximum value of eight academic quarters of enrollment. The recipient must enroll in a minimum of six (6) credit hours per quarter and remain in good academic standing to retain the scholarship.

The President is authorized to establish guidelines for administering the scholarship program.
