CITING RESEARCH DATABASES APA STYLE

The following guidelines are taken from *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (7th edition).

GENERAL RULES

See APA 9.3, 9.34, and 9.35

- 1. Follow the rules for citing a print copy of the source.
- 2. Complete the citation with the DOI (Digital Object Identifier) for all works that have one.
 - a. Use this format: https://doi.org/xxxxx

For example, if the DOI is **10.1016/j.addbeh.2020.106327** use **https://doi.org/10.1016/j.addbeh.2020.106327** in your reference.

- b. Do not place a period after the DOI
- c. When a DOI is long or complex, you may use shortDOIs. Use the shortDOI service provided by the International DOI Foundation (http://shortdoi.org) to create shortDOIs.

3. Do **not** provide the database name or URL (Uniform Resource Locator).
