

# CITING RESEARCH DATABASES MLA STYLE

## *Gale eBooks*

---

The guidelines in this handout are based on the *MLA Handbook* (9<sup>th</sup> ed.). Follow them when citing an encyclopedia article from Gale eBooks.

### URLs

1. Because encyclopedia articles in Gale eBooks have not been assigned a **DOI** (Digital Object Identifier), your citation should include the **URL** (Uniform Resource Locator) instead.
2. To view the URL, scroll to the end of the article until you see **Source Citation** and select **MLA 9th Edition** (it may be selected by default).
3. If the URL takes up more than one line, do not insert spaces or hyphens to force a break. Use your computer's **Enter/Return** key instead.

## Encyclopedia article from Gale eBooks

To cite an encyclopedia article, scroll down the screen until you see the **Source Citation**. Please note that the citations in Gale eBooks aren't always completely accurate and you may need to correct a few mistakes.
