Admission into CHI Health's Radiologic Technology program is based on a point system. The more courses that are completed and the higher the GPA, the more points the student receives toward admission.

**In addition to the courses listed above, students can earn points toward admission by working in health care positions such as:**

- Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) – can be taken through MCC (HLTH 1200)
- Medical Assistant (MA) – can be obtained through MCC Medical Assisting Program (MDACE)
- Secretary in hospital / clinic
- Admissions clerk
- Patient escort

#### Notes:

- Radiologic Technology is a 2-year program that is divided into 4 semesters. Courses begin in late August.
- Application Deadline: February 1 every year
- Completion of all courses listed above **does not guarantee** admission to the Radiologic Technology program. Overall GPA of 2.8 or higher is most beneficial for acceptance.
- The program admits 12 – 14 students each year.
- Upon completion of the program, students are awarded an AAS in Radiologic Technology and, meeting all other American Registry of Radiology Technologists (AART) criteria, will be eligible to sit for certification exam.
- For admission, students need to:
  - Submit all grade transcripts from high school, college, or any other school attended, Submit four references (names of 4 people not related to you). See CHI Health site for reference form or contact the School of Radiologic Technology.
  - Complete Keystone Entrance Examination given by the program in February of each year, followed by interviews. Class selection is completed by April 1.
